FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR YAYASAN SABAH GROUP SPONSORED STUDENTS

KOTA KINABALU (Thursday): Yayasan Sabah Group provides financial support to its sponsored students which consist of 37 students currently studying in Sarawak and another 58 students in the Middle East as a sign of concern over the COVID-19 global pandemic outbreak including Malaysia.

The students who are stranded in Sarawak involved those studying at SM Sains Miri, Kolej Datu Patinggi Abang Haji Abdillah, Kuching, SMK Agama Matang 2, Kuching, SMK Agama Miri, SM Sains, Kuching, Sekolah Menengah Sains Kuching Utara, Kuching and SM Sains Miri. Meanwhile, students stranded in the Middle East involved 48 students studying in Cairo, Egypt and ten students in Jordan.

With regards to the student's plight, the Director of Yayasan Sabah, Datuk Haji Jamalul Kiram bin Datuk Haji Mohd. Zakaria said, "Yayasan Sabah Group clearly understands the difficulties faced by these students who are unable to return to Sabah. Therefore, every student affected in Sarawak is provided with RM200 each while students in the Middle East received RM300 each and the financial assistance goes directly to the student's bank account."
